



## JLM New Member Requirements

### **Residency**

To be eligible, a candidate must satisfy one of the following residency requirements:

#### **1. Resident Candidate**

Be a resident of Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Waukesha or Washington counties at the time of application or by the date of expected completion of the New Member course. The Board of Directors may grant exceptions

#### **2. Non-Resident Candidate**

- To be eligible, a candidate must satisfy one of the following residency requirements: (1) Be a resident of Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Waukesha or Washington counties at the time of application or by the date of expected completion of the New Member course. The Board of Directors may grant exception; or (2) Be a resident within the admissions area of another Junior League on the date the application is submitted

### **Additional New Member Requirements**

- Complete and submit Membership Registration form and \$170 New Member Fee
- Earn 15 - 16 points during the league year
- Attend at least (5) New Member Orientation classes (including the mandatory first class)
- Attend at least (2) General Membership Meetings (GMM)
- Complete (1) Community Shifts (Done In A Day) and/or (1) Community Partner Donation
- Placement on a New Member Provisional Committee (Blood Drive, Social, Brew City Bash or Service Project)
- Participate in New Member Service Project
- Support the New Member Blood Drive

### **Additional Opportunities to Participate in the League (Optional for New Members)**

- Attend additional General Membership Meetings
- Participate in additional community and fundraiser volunteer shifts
- Contribute to the "Every Member Campaign"
- Attend annual fundraiser - Brew City Bash
