2023-2024 Provisional Year

During your first year in the Junior League of Milwaukee, you will attend monthly meetings to learn about the League's history and operations. We provide our provisional members with numerous opportunities to volunteer with local community partners, attend professional development programs, and network with other members.

Provisional Year Commitment

As part of the Provisional Membership Program, provisional members commit to completing the following objectives:

- Submitting the New Member Registration form
- Attending 5 Provisional Membership Meetings
- Participating on a Provisional Committee
- Paying the \$170 New Member Fee

Provisional Member Meetings Overview

Provisional membership meetings occur approximately once a month between September and April. Meetings are usually held on weeknights, beginning at approximately 6:30 pm. Meeting topics include History, Operations, Committee Structure, and Online Membership Resources.

League Opportunities

Provisional members have the same access to opportunities as current members—referred to as Actives and Sustainers. This includes service and fundraising events, networking socials, seminars, and general membership meetings.

Residency Requirement

To join, provisional members must satisfy one of the following:

- A resident of Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Waukesha, or Washington County at the time of application or by the date of program completion; or
- An employee or business owner in Milwaukee, Ozaukee, Waukesha, or Washington County at the time of application or by the date of program completion.

Exceptions can be made to the above with League approval
